DAY 1 — VIP AIRPORT GREETING - SJO



Welcome to Costa Rica! Upon arrival to

Juan Santamaria International Airport, you will receive a VIP Airport Greeting by a Toucan Maps Inc./Costa Rica Guide representative who'll help load your luggage into the waiting private transportation to the elegant Hotel Grano de Oro, located in San Jose.



HOTEL GRANO DE ORO (1 NIGHT)

Converted from a Tropical Victorian mansion, the well-appointed 40-room hotel maintains the warmth and comfort of a private home. Within walking distance to cafes, theaters, shops and museums.



DAY 2 — LAGUNA LODGE (2 NIGHTS)

Today your adventure begins! Transportation will be provided through the cloud forests of Braulio Carrillo National Park and out to the Tortuguero Canals. When you reach the canals, you will board a covered riverboat

bound for Laguna Lodge in Tortuguero. Upon arrival, you will be greeted with a "welcome cocktail". After lunch, you will be brought to visit the town of Tortuguero and the Turtle museum (Does not include \$3 entrance).



OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES

Turtle nesting tours are available for an additional fee July through October.

DAY 3 — WILDLIFE TOURS

An optional early bird 6am wildlife observation tour is available for those of you that cannot wait to investigate Tortuguero National Park.

After breakfast is served, you will go on a guided walk to Tortuguero National park with a naturalist guide (photos). With a little luck, your guide will point out some of the abundant wildlife such as

monkeys, sloths, toucans, parrots, crocodiles etc. (Does not include \$10 entrance)

DAY 4 — EL SILENCIO DEL CAMPO (3 NIGHTS)

After breakfast is served, a boat transfer will be provided back to the docks. A transfer will be awaiting to bring you to Hotel el Silencio del Campo.



Surrounded by tropical gardens and a grand view of Volcan Arenal, this La Fortuna hotel has been built around a “small village” concept. The "village" is comprised of private bungalows with two large picture windows, private patio, swimming pools, one for adults and one for children and a full-service restaurant. After a long day of adventuring, you will be able to cool down in the pool or unwind in their private hot spring fed pool.



DAY 5 — ZIPLINE CANOPY TOUR

Be sure to eat a light breakfast! Today you will go on a high speed, high flying canopy zipline adventure. On this gravity defying adventure, you will soar through the canopy of the rain forest on zipline cables, suspended by wheel and harness across 15 cables and top it off with a giant Tarzan swing (only if you're up for it of course)!!!

OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES

For those that desire a little slower pace, the Arenal Hanging Bridges or Bird Watching Tour can be substituted at no additional charge.



DAY 6 — HIKING & VIEWING ARENAL VOLCANO

After a morning and early afternoon of becoming acclimated with your new surroundings, you will be guided on an easy hike through the rain forest at the base of Arenal Volcano (photos). Your bilingual guide will

point out some of the many wonders of the tropical forest and with a little luck point out wildlife such as monkeys and sloths. When you reach the clearing, you will be at the closest safe observation point. A drink will be provided and hopefully with a little cooperation from Mother Nature, you will have the opportunity to view lava spewing from the volcano.

ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES

Hot Springs and dinner options such as Baldi, Ecotermals, The Springs or Tabacon can be added for an additional charge

DAY 7 — ADIÓS ¡HASTA LUEGO!

A Private transfer will bring you back to Juan Santamaria International Airport, scheduled to arrive 3 hours prior to your departing flight. Save some hassle when you're headed home by paying your \$26 departure tax in advance when you arrive (on the right as you enter the departure area).
